Domaine Cécile Chassagne was established in 1998 and has since cultivated a reputation for producing wines of elegance, purity and focus that offer all the headiness of Gigondas but without the excess.

Cécile's vineyard holdings covers just 1.5 ha of the 'La Pourra' lieu-dits; a terraced vineyard in the heart of the Dentelles de Montmirail, which was planted in 1970 by her father, Jean-Claude Chassagne. The site reaches a height of 300m above sealevel, the soils are comprised mainly of stoney red-clay alluvium and is planted to three classic Rhone varieties: Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre. Producing only one cuvée means they can focus their energies on careful vineyard management and astute winemaking.

Vinification is traditional, taking place in large wooden tanks, over a period of up to 20 days at moderate temperatures and usually incorporate a high-proportion of whole-bunches. The wine is aged for approximately 6 months in 3 year-old Allier Barriques

2017 in the Southern Rhone is being heralded as on a par qualitatively with the exciting 2015 vintage. Yields however, were dramatically down on previous years. This, combined with the size restrictions of the site have resulted in a smaller than usual allocation landing on our shores.

Good things come in small packages, and this years release from this exciting producer provides a stellar follow-up to the inspiring release of last years 2016's.
